


UNIFORM GUIDELINES 2016

Dear Parent/Carer,

As we prepare for the new school term, I thought it would be helpful to send a reminder regarding uniform expectations.

We want our children to be smart and part of our school community. This is identified by our unique logo. The Governors of Allerton CE agreed the uniform and would ask all parents to follow the guidance.

The school logo on ALL jumpers and cardigans, is really important.

<p>Sweatshirt/Cardigan in red – with school logo on</p> <p>Grey Trousers- boys and girls</p>	<p>Red and white gingham dress - girls</p> <p>Grey pinafore or skirt or Grey culottes – girls</p>	
<p>White shirt OR White polo shirt (plain or with logo)</p>	<p>Tie (to be worn with a shirt)</p>	
<p>Headscarf in grey/black Ramaal, Patka or Turban in grey/black</p>	<p>Black shoes</p> <p>Grey, black or white tights/socks</p>	
<p>Jeggings and leggings are not appropriate and should be not be purchased for school.</p> <p>Tight fitting, lycra fashion skirts and short skirts are NOT permitted.</p>		
<p>PE Red or black shorts House T-shirt OR white T-shirt(whilst growing out!) Black tracksuit. (this can be plain or with logo)</p> <p>Trainers Change of socks – for sport</p>	<p><u>Summer</u> Grey shorts/Polo shirt – boys/girls Red checked dress - girls</p>	
<p>Hairstyles haircuts that are shaved (below grade 2), partially shaves (including tram lines) or dyed, are not permitted.</p>	<p>Jewellery One small plain stud allowed in each ear lobe, a watch is permitted. No other Jewellery or piercings. Religious jewellery is permitted – please see staff.</p>	
<p>Make-Up (including nail polish, gel, shellac and false nails) is not permitted.</p>	<p>Hair bands/bobbles either the logo ones OR small and functional (not huge!)</p>	

Our new PE kit will be introduced from September. We understand that some children will still be wearing white T-shirts and red shorts, as they still fit and you are waiting for them to grow out of them, before buying the new kit.
