## The school will do its best to:

- Provide an environment which has been risk assessed in response to the COVID-19 infection.
  - Adhere to the social distancing rules as set out by the government as much as we reasonably can.
  - Provide a curriculum that meets the needs of your child's well-being, mental health, and academic needs.
  - Contact parents/carers if your child displays symptoms of COVID-19. (High temperature, persistent dry cough, loss of sense of taste and smell)
  - Inform you if staff or children in your child's 'bubble'\* show symptoms of COVID-19 as this will mean you will all need to self-isolate for at least 14 days or until the test comes back negative.
  - Continue our clear and consistent approach to rewards and sanctions for children as set out in the Behaviour Policy as well the expectations outlined in this agreement.
  - Communicate between home and school through newsletters, school app and the school website and avoid sending any items home from school.
  - Ensure that children have their own work space and equipment solely for their own use, to ensure safe physical distancing and lessen the risk of infection.
  - Staff are expected to follow all guidance given and have signed documentation confirming that they will do so.
- \*bubble** – a group of people with whom you have closer physical contact, located in a separate physical space, limiting interactions with individuals in other bubbles, lessening the risk of infection.

## To help my child at school, I know and understand:

- If my child, or anyone in my household, shows symptoms of COVID-19, I will check their temperature and I will not send them to school. We will self-isolate for 14 days as a family, I will get them tested and I will let the school know as soon as possible via telephone or email.
- If my child, or another child in their bubble, shows symptoms of COVID-19 at school, I will collect my child from school immediately.
- On my commute, and when dropping my child off and picking them up, I will adhere to the 2 metre physical distancing rules and the school timings given.
- My child must not bring any items into school with them or take items home from school.
- I will need to remind my child about physical distancing rules but accept they are difficult to follow and that my child may not always do this successfully.
- My child will need to use good respiratory and hand hygiene.
- I will not be allowed into the school.
- I need to support all staff in their efforts to create an 'as safe as possible' environment during this crisis.
- Read all letters/messages that are sent home.
- I need to inform the school immediately of any changes to parents/carers and emergency contacts details.
- If my child is deemed unsafe, he/she will be sent home and cannot return to school until they can be safe.
- If I do not adhere to the expectations of this agreement, my child will be sent home.




- Tell an adult if I feel unwell.

- Only use the equipment provided to me by school and no other.
- Only use the toys that are out in the classroom. Do not get new toys out of the draws.
- Stay in my 'bubble' at all times and not mix with other children in other bubbles. 
- Only enter and exit the school building from the gate and door I have been told to use.
- Wash my hands when entering school and when asked to do so by an adult 
- Follow good hand hygiene – use soap and water for 20 seconds/ hand sanitiser.
- Keep others safe by behaving in a sensible and considerate way.
- Follow these expectations and know that if I do not - I will be sent home and will not be able to come back into school until I can be safe.
